ATTENTION RESIDENTS

PLEASE BE AWARE OF TWO CHANGES REGARDING
BOROUGH STREETS
IMPLEMENTED BY MEYERSDALE BOROUGH COUNCIL

1. **ORDINANCE #439 WAS ENACTED, ESTABLISHING SIXTH STREET AS A ONE-WAY STREET FROM DALE STREET TO MAIN STREET. (THIS IS THE STREET BETWEEN THOMAS DRUG STORE AND PRICE FUNERAL HOME) DO NOT ENTER SIXTH STREET FROM THE MAIN STREET SIDE.**
2. **RESOLUTION 9-2022 WAS ENACTED, ESTABLISHING FOUR WAY STOP SIGNS AT THE INTERSECTION OF 4TH AVENUE AND SALISBURY STREET. IT WAS NECESSARY TO ESTABLISH A FOUR WAY STOP AND FOUR WAY STOP SIGNS AS A SAFETY ISSUE DUE TO SPEEDING IN THIS AREA.**

BOTH ITEMS WERE DISCUSSED AND ACTED ON IN OPEN SESSIONS OF MEYERSDALE BOROUGH COUNCIL, WITH AMPLE TIME PROVIDED FOR PUBLIC COMMENT. WARNINGS WILL NO LONGER BE GIVEN, VIOLATORS WILL BE GIVEN CITATIONS BY THE MEYERSDALE BOROUGH POLICE DEPARTMENT.
