The recycling shed at Meyersdale Area High School will now be locked due to violations of the rules of conduct. Anyone wishing to drop off items will need to schedule an appointment at email mciverb@masd.net. Drop-offs will only be accessible during school hours.

To maintain the functionality of our recycling shed and keep it open to the public, please adhere to the following rules:

We will only be accepting sorted (no mixed bags) recyclables that include: plastics #1 and #2; glass; aluminum cans; tin cans; and cardboard and paper (office paper, newspaper, magazines).

The following items are NOT accepted: Containers from alcoholic products (this is an alcohol-free zone); plastic bags; paper towels, toilet paper, napkins; cardboard that contained food (e.g., pizza boxes, milk cartons); any recyclable container with food waste; and aluminum foil.
