



Wi-Fi Policy

1. The Meyersdale Public Library provides a wireless Internet connection. This service is for patrons with wireless capable devices, such as laptops, tablets, e-readers and smart phones.
2. Library staff cannot configure patrons' laptops or handheld devices or install any software. Technical support is only available from the wireless service vendor.
3. Wireless networks are not secure, and use is at the individual's own risk. Virus, security, and privacy protection are the responsibility of the patron and are not provided by the library.
4. The library is not responsible for any damage to data files, alteration to file systems, or functionality of the computer resulting from connecting to the wireless network.
5. The library is not responsible for damage, theft, and loss of property, personal information, software, or other personal property used in the library.
6. The library cannot guarantee Internet speed or quality of the connection.
7. Currently no printing can be done on the wireless network. Please save work to a USB drive and print from a desktop computer.
8. The Wi-Fi connection cannot be used for illegal purposes, nor shall it be used in any way that violates library policies.
9. The Meyersdale Public Library assumes no responsibility for the use of the Internet by children. It is the responsibility of the parent or guardian to determine what is appropriate for children. Parents who believe their children cannot responsibly use the library's Internet access workstations are requested to monitor their children's Internet use.
10. By using this free wireless service, patrons agree to abide by Meyersdale Public Library's Computer & Internet Policy Statement. Patrons are required to familiarize themselves with the foregoing policies and procedures.
