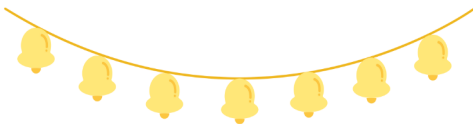
Amity United Church of Christ announces:
